TUITION

Junior Kindergarten & Kindergarten	\$ 12,030
First through Fifth Grade	\$ 13,785
Sixth through Eighth Grade	\$ 14,910

Tuition at Charlotte Christian School includes the following: textbooks for all grades, language arts novels, physical education uniforms and a daily lunch program provided by Flik food services. Additionally, for middle and upper school students tuition includes Windy Gap fees and caps and gowns for seniors.

FEES

- **Enrollment Fee:** **\$800 for first child**
\$400 for each additional child
The enrollment fee is due at enrollment to reserve a student's place in a grade. The enrollment fee is **nonrefundable** and is applied to the tuition balance.
- **New Family Fee:** **\$750 per new family**
The new family fee is nonrefundable and is paid at the same time as the enrollment fee. This is a one time fee only.
- **Installment Fee:** 10 month payment plan. **\$250 per student**, includes required Tuition Protection Program.
- **Tuition Protection Program (TPP):** **\$200 per student**
Recommended for families that pay in full.

DISCOUNTS

- **Payment in Full:** New students are eligible for a \$200 credit per student if they pay tuition in full within two weeks of acceptance.
- **Family Fellowship:** \$1,500 tuition credit for third, fourth, or fifth students enrolled from the same household.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- **One-Time Fee:** \$2,500 for newly accepted international students. It is paid in lieu of the new family fee.
- **Re-enrollment Fee:** \$500 for re-enrolling international students. The international student fee is nonrefundable and due at enrollment.

How to Apply for Financial Aid

1. All families applying for financial aid must complete the Parents' Financial Statement (PFS) form that is part of the financial need assessment provided by School and Student Services (SSS), an independent evaluation service of the National Association of Independent Schools. These forms and instructions for completion may be accessed at sss.nais.org and should be submitted using Charlotte Christian's school code, 2318.
2. Families who are unable to apply online for financial aid should contact Mrs. Janet Aldridge in the Admissions Office at (704) 366-5657, ext. 6503.
3. In order to meet the Charlotte Christian deadlines for financial aid priority consideration, the PFS form must be completed/received by School and Student Services no later than Monday, February 6, 2012. In addition to the PFS form, the following documents should be uploaded to the SSS website.
 - 2010 income tax return, 2011 income tax return when available
 - 2011 W-2 Form (available in January 2012)
 - If you own all or part of a business, you must submit your business tax return.
4. Should you have specific questions about completing the Parents' Financial Statement form, please call the School and Student Services Helpline at: (800) 344-8328 (Monday – Friday 9 a.m. – 8 p.m. EST, or Saturday 9 a.m. – 4 p.m. EST).
5. Financial aid awards will be provided to returning families within 10 business days of application completion. Awards for new families will not be provided until students have been accepted to Charlotte Christian School.

All tuition assistance grants are based on financial need. In order to provide assistance to as many families as possible, the maximum financial aid award from the Tuition Assistance program is limited to 50 percent of tuition. Families are responsible for all other school fees including, but not limited to, installment and tuition protection plan fees, and other school related costs. Applications for financial assistance received after February 6, 2012 will be considered, but awards may be limited by the funding available beyond this date.
