

IF YOU TEST POSITIVE » SYMPTOMATIC »

POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST »

**contact health room »
must stay home and quarantine »
may return when »**

- It has been 5 days since symptoms onset (first day of symptoms is considered day 0.)
- On day 6 you may return to campus activities if symptoms are improving and you have been fever free for 24 hours without the use of medication.
- You are contagious for 10 days. Day 0 is the date symptoms started.
- Student must mask while on campus unless eating or drinking until their contagious period is over.

ASYMPTOMATIC »

POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST NO SYMPTOMS »

contact health room »

- If the person has a repeat PCR test performed within 24-48 hours of their initial positive test and that PCR test is negative; the positive rapid test can be considered a false positive and the student can immediately return.
- If you do not get retested or your PCR test is positive, you must stay home for 5 days. (Day of test is considered day 0.)
- On day 6 you may return to campus activities if you remain asymptomatic.
- You are contagious for 10 days. Day 0 is the date symptoms started.
- Student must mask while on campus unless eating or drinking until their contagious period is over.

STUDENT IS NOT FEELING WELL »

SICK POLICY »

Students may return to campus once they have been symptom free for 24 hours without the use of medication. This applies IF a negative COVID-19 test is not required.

A NEGATIVE COVID-19 TEST IS REQUIRED TO RETURN IF ANY OF THE BELOW APPLIES »

If you are experiencing any symptoms and have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.

OR

IF STUDENT HAS ONE OF THE FOLLOWING HIGH RISK SYMPTOMS »

- Fever
- Chills
- New cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Loss of taste or smell

OR TWO OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING SYMPTOMS »

- Sore throat
- Upset stomach or nausea
- Diarrhea and/or vomiting
- Muscle pain or fatigue
- Congestion or runny nose
- Headache

Student must stay home until »

- Submit a negative COVID-19 test (rapid, PCR or at-home tests accepted) **AND**
- In the past 24 hours you have been fever free without the use of fever reducing medication and symptoms are improving.
- If you choose not to test you may return when 5 days have passed since the start of symptoms (date symptoms began is considered day 0.)

ONLINE LEARNING »

Only those students who have tested positive and are being required to quarantine will be transitioned to online learning. Please keep in mind this will take 24 hours to begin.

PRIOR COVID-19 DIAGNOSIS » IMMUNITY »

If someone has recovered from COVID-19 in the past 90 days and is exposed again, they do not need to quarantine if all of the following are true »

- Their illness was laboratory confirmed in the past 90 days and submitted to the health room.
- If any symptoms develop within 14 days following exposure, a negative PCR test will be required before returning to campus.
