



Admissions Visitor COVID-19 Protocol

Before coming to campus, visitors should complete the following self-screening:

1. Take your temperature - if you have a fever of 100 degrees F or greater, stay home.

Fever-free without the use of any medicines to reduce it such as acetaminophen (Tylenol), ibuprofen (Advil) or naproxen sodium (Aleve).

2. Wash your hands

3. Please ask yourself the following questions:

If, at any point in the last 72 hrs, you have experienced any of the following do NOT come to campus:

- ☐ A fever (greater than 100 degrees F) or chills in the past 72 hours (*without the use of any medication*)
- ☐ Chills
- ☐ Cough
- ☐ Shortness of Breath or Difficulty Breathing
- ☐ Loss of Taste or Smell

Exposures:

If you answer yes, to any of the following exposures, you must self-quarantine and contact admissions BEFORE coming to campus. In the past 14 days:

- ☐ You, or someone in your household, are showing any symptoms of COVID-19,
- ☐ You think you might have COVID-19,
- ☐ You have tested positive for COVID-19,
- ☐ You are awaiting the results of testing for COVID-19 (if you were tested due to symptoms for COVID)
- ☐ Is anyone in your household awaiting COVID-19 test results?
- ☐ You have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19?

We ask that you notify the Health Room if you or anyone on your party test positive within 48 hours or have symptoms develop within 48 hours of being on campus followed by a positive COVID-19 test. This will enable us to notify those that would be close contacts and keep our campus safe. Your information will be kept confidential. While on Campus:

Practice Good Hygiene

1. **Face Masks:** We ask that visitors wear a face mask. If they do not have a face mask, one will be provided.
2. **A hand sanitizer station** will be available in the Hendrick Center reception area and we will encourage visitors to use this upon arrival. Handshakes and hugs are discouraged.
3. **Practice social distancing** while visiting campus.
4. **Group Size:** We are limiting our campus tour groups to four or less and only to members of one family per visit.

The protocol outlined above is based on NC Phase II guidelines (State of NC Executive Order 141) and are intended to be updated throughout the course of North Carolina's phased reopening plan.
