HAPPENSTANCE OR PROVIDENCE?

RUTH CH. 2 - UNDER GOD'S WINGS

Providence establishes **God's** <u>absolute</u> **lordship** over His creation and affirms we are all dependent on Him and refutes the universe is governed by fate or chance.

LAW OF SINAI COVENANT

When you reap your harvest in your field and forget a sheaf, you shall not go back to get it.

It shall be for the sojourner, the fatherless, and the widow, that the Lord your God may bless you in all the work of your hands.

WHAT IS GLEANING?

RUTH CH. 2 - UNDER GOD'S WINGS

God ordained the practice of gathering leftover harvest grain so that marginalized people: widows, orphans, foreigners and the elderly have a means of survival.




