BABYLON

- Major city in central Mesopotamia along Euphrates River
- Ruins under suburbs of Baghdad, Iraq
- Genesis 11: Tower of Babel
- Chaldeans: astronomers

BABYLON

612 BC: Destroy Nineveh in Assyria

605/597BC: First wave of Southern Kingdom exiles to Babylon

586 BC: Destroyed Temple and Jerusalem, exiled Southern Kingdom

539BC: Babylon falls to Medes/Persia

Daniel 5: writing on the wall

BABYLON

Matthew 2:1-2: Wise men?

1 Peter 5: Babylon metaphor for Rome and symbol of wickedness

Revelation 17:5: Symbol of world under control of Satan

ASSYRIA

- Modern day northern Iraq and southeast Turkey
- Name derived from capital city, Asshur
- Descendants of Shem (Genesis 10:22)
- "Romans of the East"
- Nineveh (Jonah)

ASSYRIA

- Expanded under Kings Tiglath-pileser and Sargon II
- King Azariah (Uzziah) paid tribute and King Ahaz asked for help
- Sargon II besieged Israel for 3 years then carried away to exile (722 BC)
- 612BC Nineveh falls to Babylonians and Medes

"The Lord of hosts has sworn:
As I have planned,
so shall it be,
and as I have purposed,
so shall it stand..."

ISAIAH 14:24(ESV)

PHILISTIA (PHILISTINES)

- Possibly from Crete, Cyprus, Aegean basin
- Sea people
- Greek name "Palestine"
- Monopoly on iron and art of forging iron

PHILISTIA (PHILISTINES)

- Menace to Israel
 - Samson
 - Ark of the Covenant
 - Samuel
 - Saul, David (Goliath), Solomon
- Became vassal to Assyria
- Babylon exported them out of land
- Language and culture disappeared by time of Medes

MOAB

- Descendants of Lot and his daughter (Genesis 19)
- Usually had hostile relationship with Israel
 - Refused to let Israel pass through land
 - Hired Balaam to curse them
 - Excluded from Temple by God
 - God used them to defeat Israel during Judge period

MOAB

- Fell under Assyrian, Babylonian and Persians
- Disappeared as nation by time Israel returned from exile
- Ruth was a Moabite

DAMASCUS (ARAM/SYRIA)

- Major city in Aram/Syria
- Ancient Damascus is in ruins under modern city
- Fertile gateway from desert (known for wine)
- Sometimes rival, sometimes ally to Israel
 - Abraham (Lot and servant)
 - Controlled by David/defeated Solomon
 - Alliance with Judah against Israel (1 Kings 15)

DAMASCUS (ARAM/SYRIA)

- 735BC: King Rezin led anti-Assyrian coalition (with Israel)
 - King Tiglath-pileser swiftly captured and killed Rezin
- Became cultural city during Persian period
- Alexander (Greeks) made Antioch capital, not Damascus
- Under Roman rule (Antony gave it to Cleopatra)

DAMASCUS (ARAM/SYRIA)

 NT: Paul's conversion experience on way to Damascus + early preaching there (Acts 9)

 634BC: Passed out of Christian hands during Arabian Conquest and under Muslim rule
